PRECIS

A meeting of the City of Wollongong Traffic Committee was held on 30 September 2009 with a subsequent electronic meeting in accordance with RTA guidelines taking place on 13 October 2009 to consider two additional Road Closure Applications. The recommendations which must be determined by Council are presented.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1 In accordance with the powers delegated to Council, the minutes and recommendations of the City of Wollongong Traffic Committee (Item 22 and Items 1-2) in relation to Road Closures, be adopted.**
- 2 Appropriate persons and Departments be advised of Council's decisions.**

BACKGROUND

With respect to the Traffic Committee minutes of 30 September 2009, Items 1-21 and 23-40 have been adopted by Council through delegated authority.

Item 22 recommends Council approve Road Closures for road works or events by independent parties. All closures of Council controlled roads must be approved by Council prior to the applicant being able to control traffic on these roads. All Road Closures and Traffic Management Plans, other than for Council Events, are to be funded by the applicant and implemented at no cost to Council.

The electronic (email) meeting of the Traffic Committee on 13 October 2009, considered two applications for road closures, one in Corrimal for St Columbkille's School and the other in Gwynneville for St Brigid's Primary School.

An application has been received for the closure of the Unnamed Lane (between Robson Street and Coss Avenue) behind St Columbkille's School for the holding of the School's Family Fun Night on 6 November 2009 between 3 pm and 9 pm. A Traffic Management Plan has been presented to both RTA and Police for comment.

The Traffic Committee members approved the plans via email.

RECOMMENDATION: (Unanimous)

The Traffic Management Plan, as presented, be approved subject to Council's standard conditions for road closures.

GWYNNEVILLE

2 Vickery Street - St Brigid's Primary School Fete - 31 October 2009 7 am - 4 pm

An application has been received from St Brigid's Primary School for closure of Vickery Street, Gwynneville for the holding of the School Fete on 31 October 2009 7 am - 4 pm.

The bus company representative indicated that the only services to pass along this road are school bus services. Therefore a weekend closure does not impact on their services. Suitable detours are available for local residents.

A Traffic Management Plan has been presented to both RTA and Police for comment.

The Traffic Committee members approved the plans via email.

The Traffic Management Plan, as presented, be approved subject to Council's standard conditions for road closures.
